In 2005, the American Society for Public Administration awarded *Cops, Teachers, Counselors* its book of the year award. The book was also recognized by the Public Administration Section of the American Political Science Association as the recipient of the first Herbert A. Simon best book award. In 2006, he was named a Fellow of the National Academy of Public Administration.
