William Keeton is Assistant Vice President and Economist in the Economic Research Department at the Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City. At the Bank, he conducts research on banking and financial markets and writes regularly for the Bank's *Economic* 

*Review*. During his career at the Kansas City Fed, Bill has also been a major contributor to the Bank's public outreach program and regional economic analysis. Before joining the Kansas City Fed in 1983, he was Assistant Professor of Economics at Yale University. He also served in the Peace Corps in Colombia and worked for two years at the Council of Economic Advisers.
