While in office, he was a member of the following committees: Children and Seniors; Agriculture; Government Security and Technology; Commerce; Agriculture Budget; Financial Institutions; Rural Development; Tax; Transportation; and Joint Committee of Government Security and Technology.

He has served on the board for Associated Wholesale Grocers Kansas City (AWG), a multi-billion-dollar food cooperative supplying independently operated stores in the eastern United States. Baker has also served as a director for Frontier Farm Credit, a financial cooperative providing credit and insurance services to farmers, ranchers, agribusinesses, and rural residents in the eastern counties of Kansas.

Community service has always been a priority for Baker. He helped establish Council Grove's Washunga Days festival, the Riverwalk Association, and annual 4^{th} of July celebration. He has also held multiple leadership roles within the local Rotary Club and the United Methodist Church.
