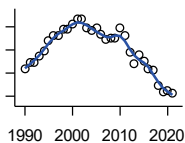

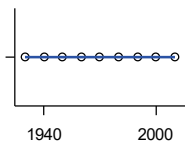

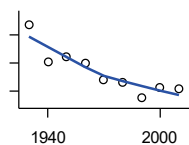

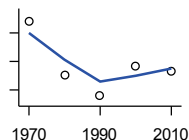

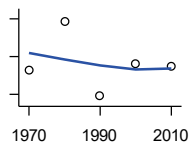

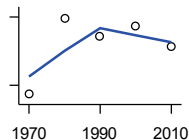
**POPULATION AGE 18 AND OVER

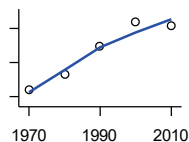
**POPULATION AGE 65 AND OVER

(DECENNIAL CENSUS)**



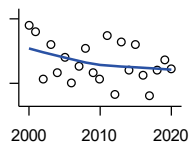

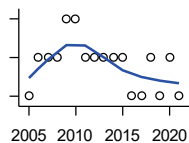

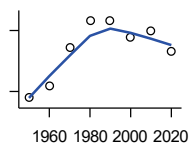

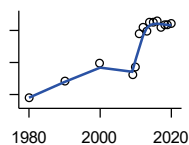

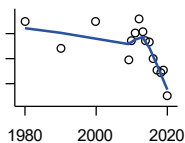

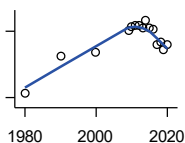

**PERCENT HS GRADUATE OR HIGHER AGE 25+**

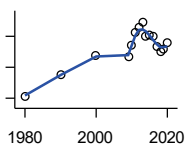

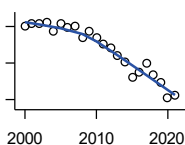

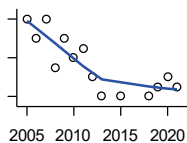

**CHILD CARE FACILITIES: TOTAL CHILD CARE FACILITIES**



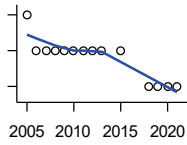

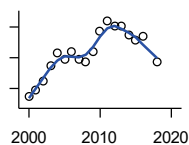

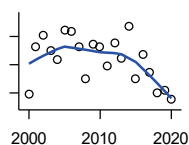

**ESTIMATED NUMBER OF PEOPLE IN POVERTY**

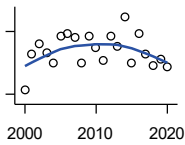

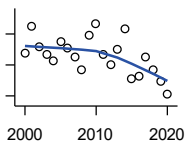

**ESTIMATED PERCENT UNDER 18 IN POVERTY**



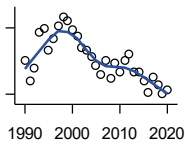

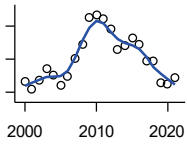

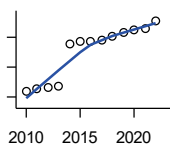

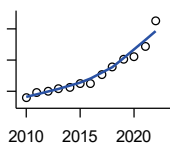

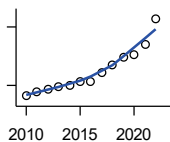
**HUD 50% LOW-TO-MEDIUM INCOME (LMI) LIMIT - 4 PERSONS**

**TANGIBLE ASSESSED VALUATION (KDoR, million\$; 2006-)**



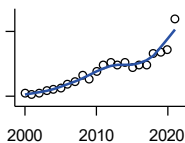

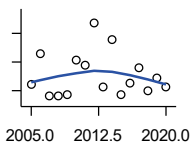

**CRIME INDEX OFFENSES**



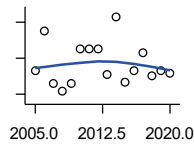

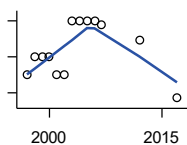
