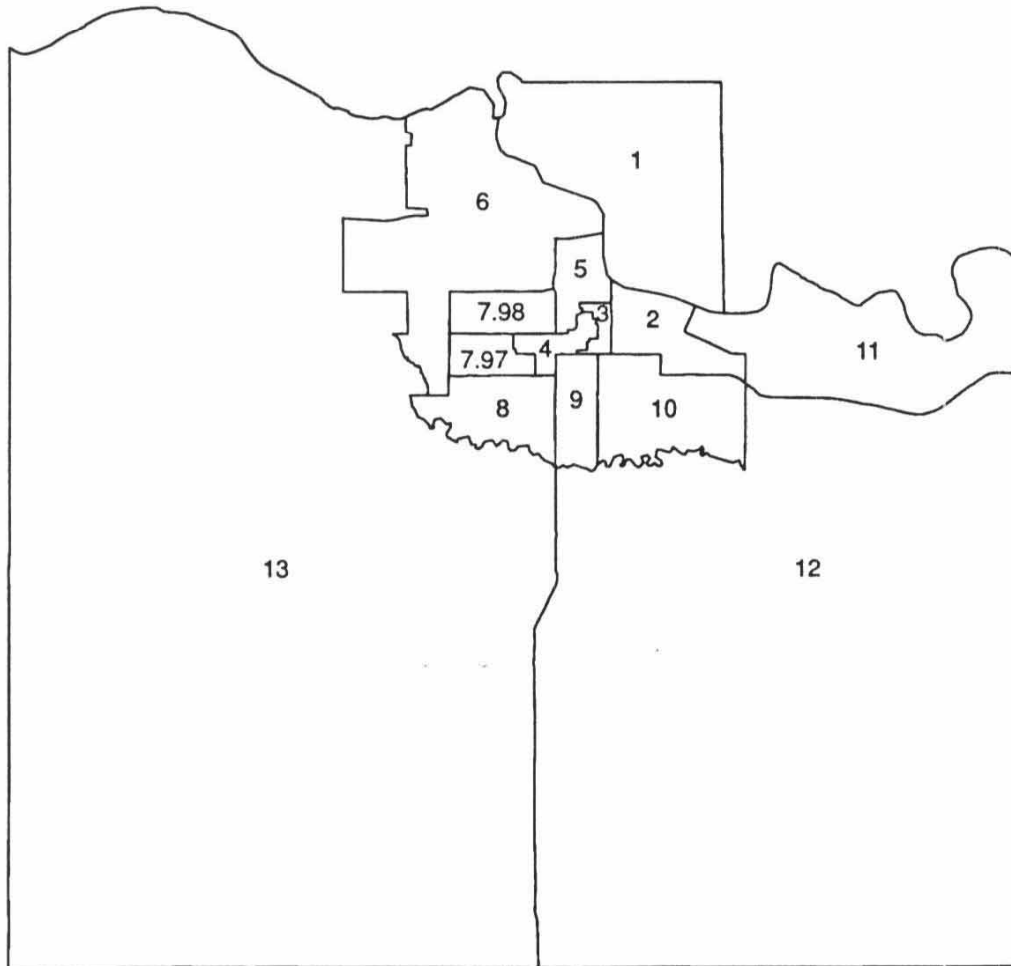

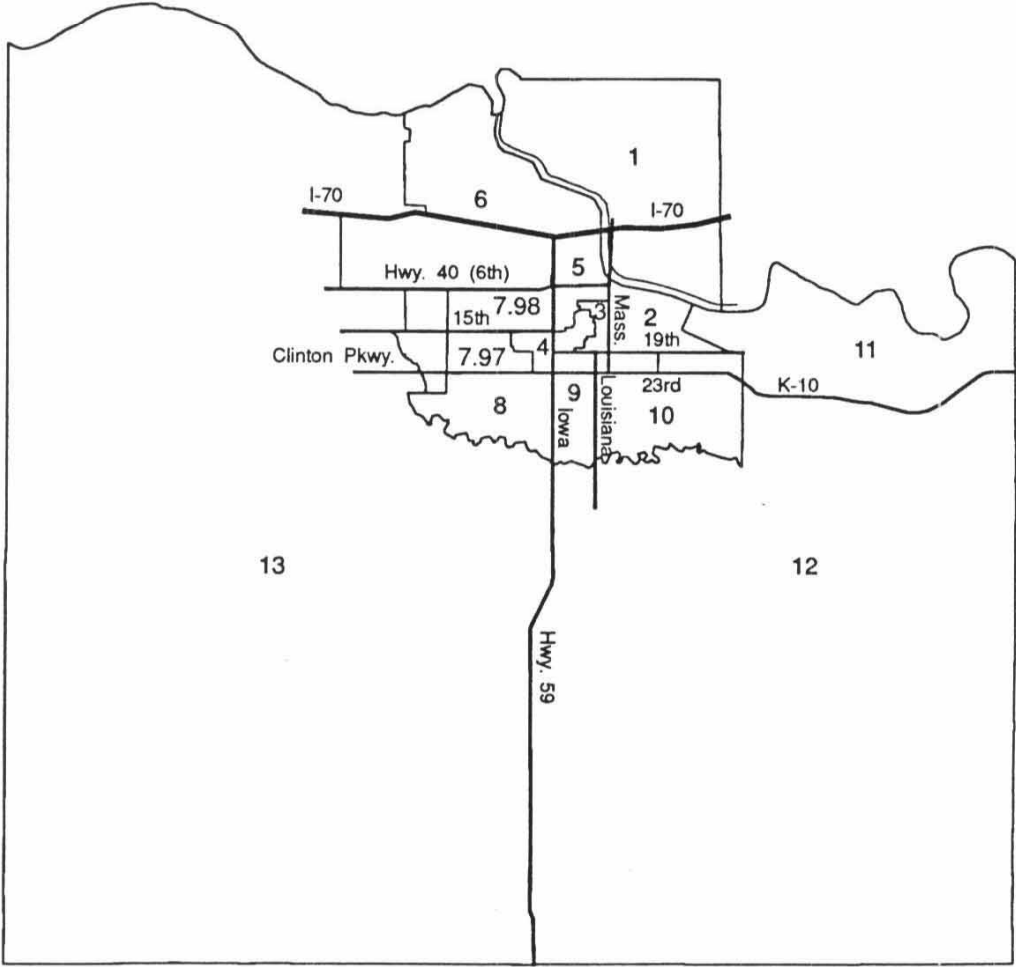

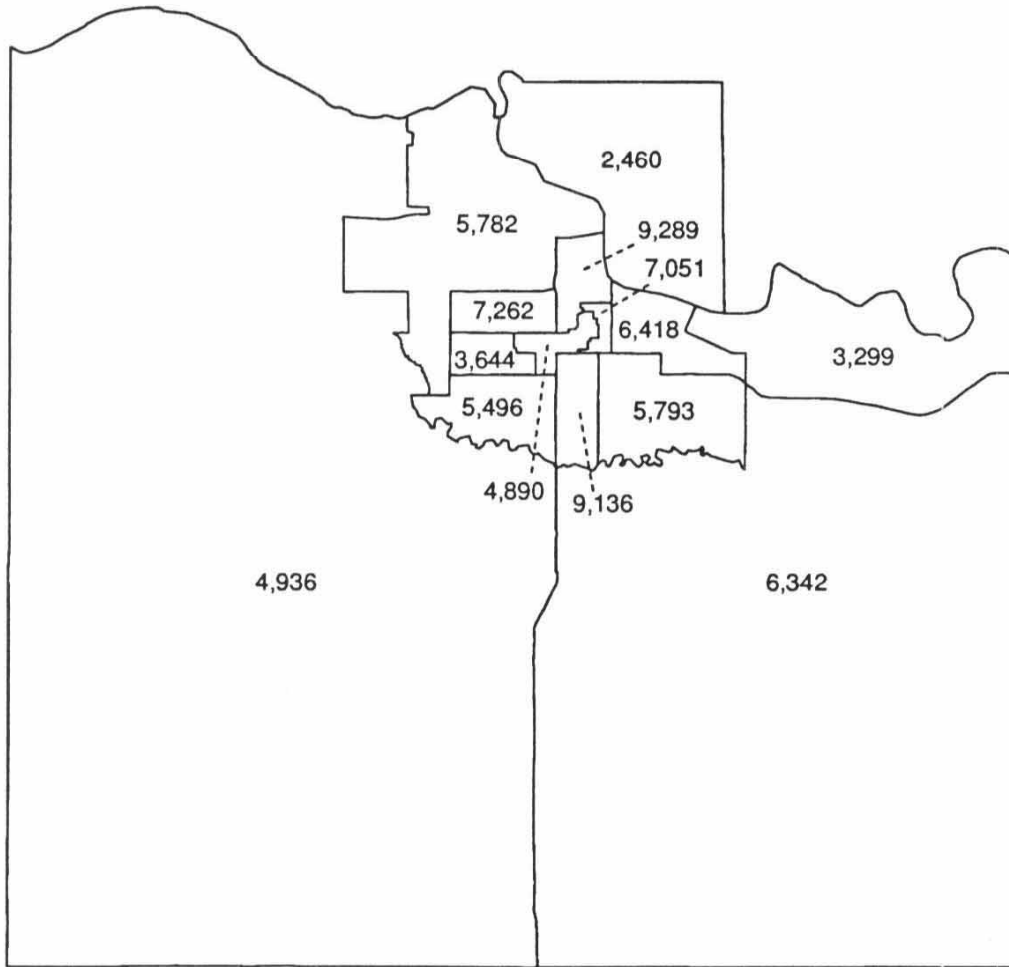
# Douglas County and Lawrence Census Tracts

with Major Highways and Streets



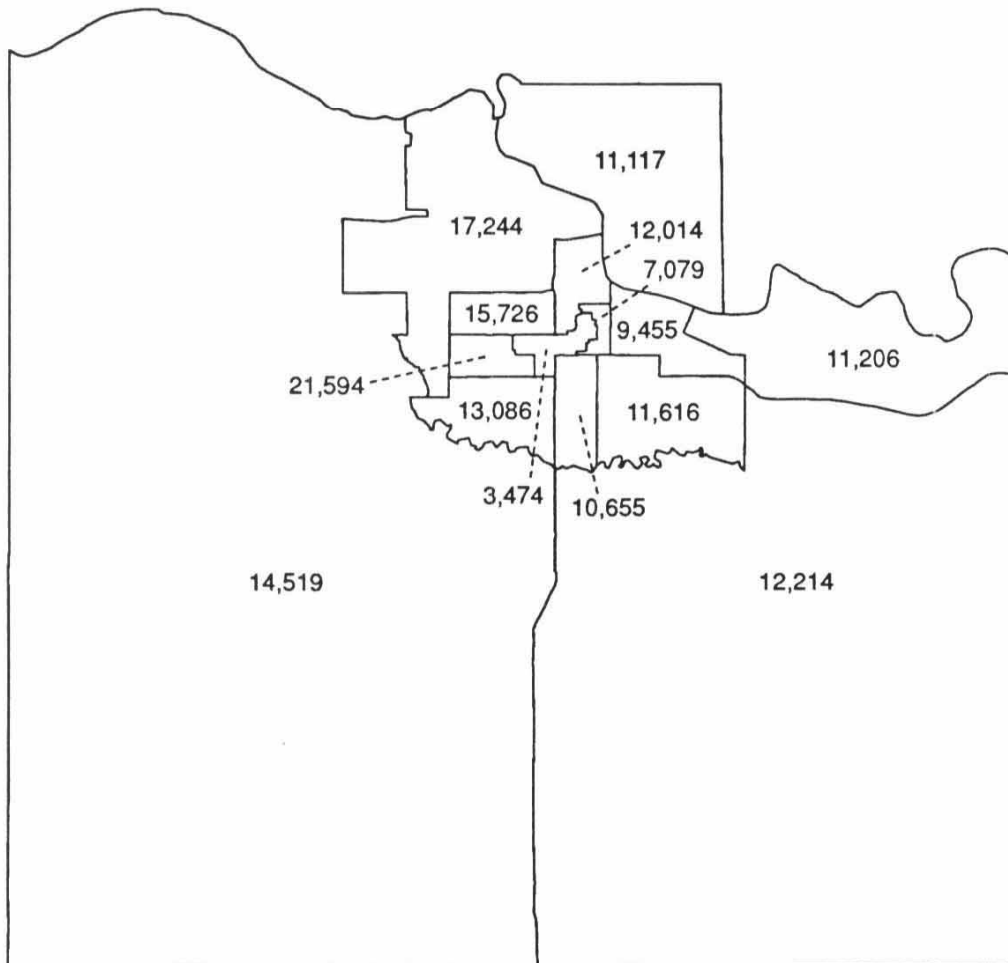
Distribution of Population, April 1, 1990

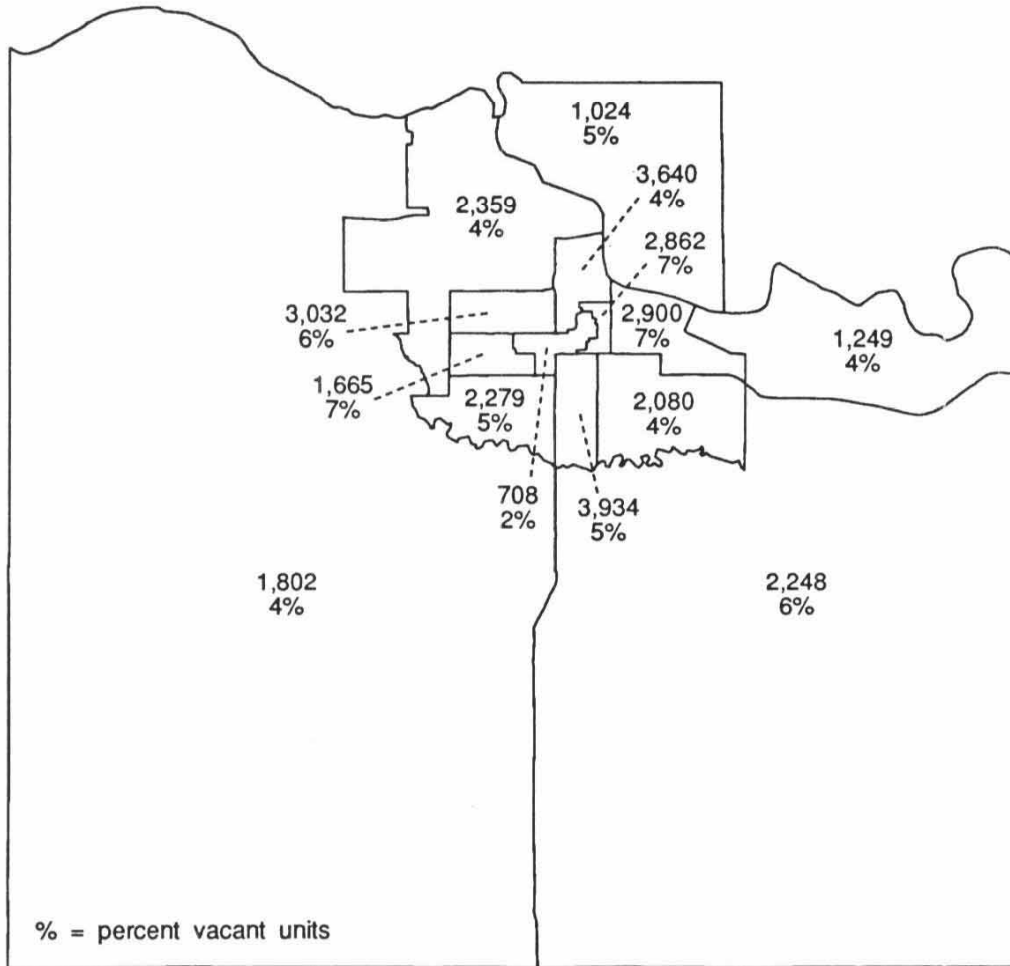
# Per Capita Income, 1989

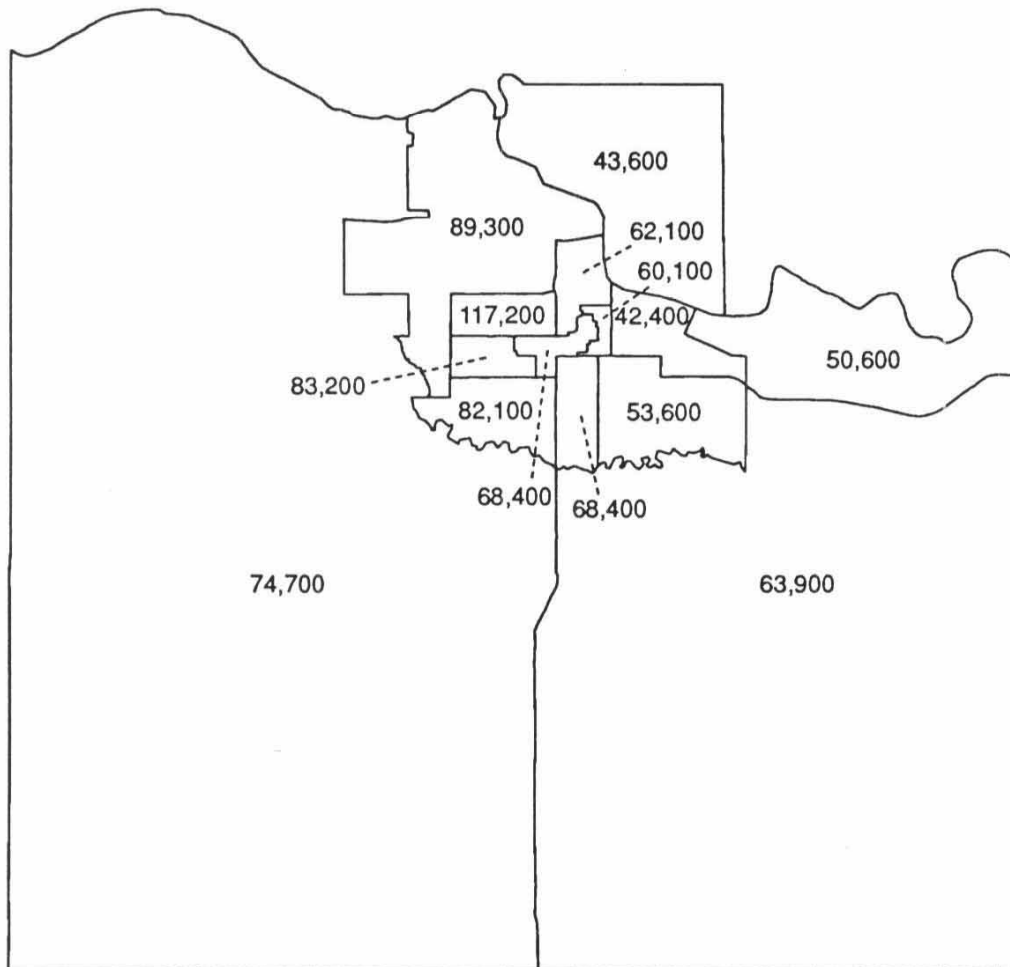
## Number of Housing Units, 1990

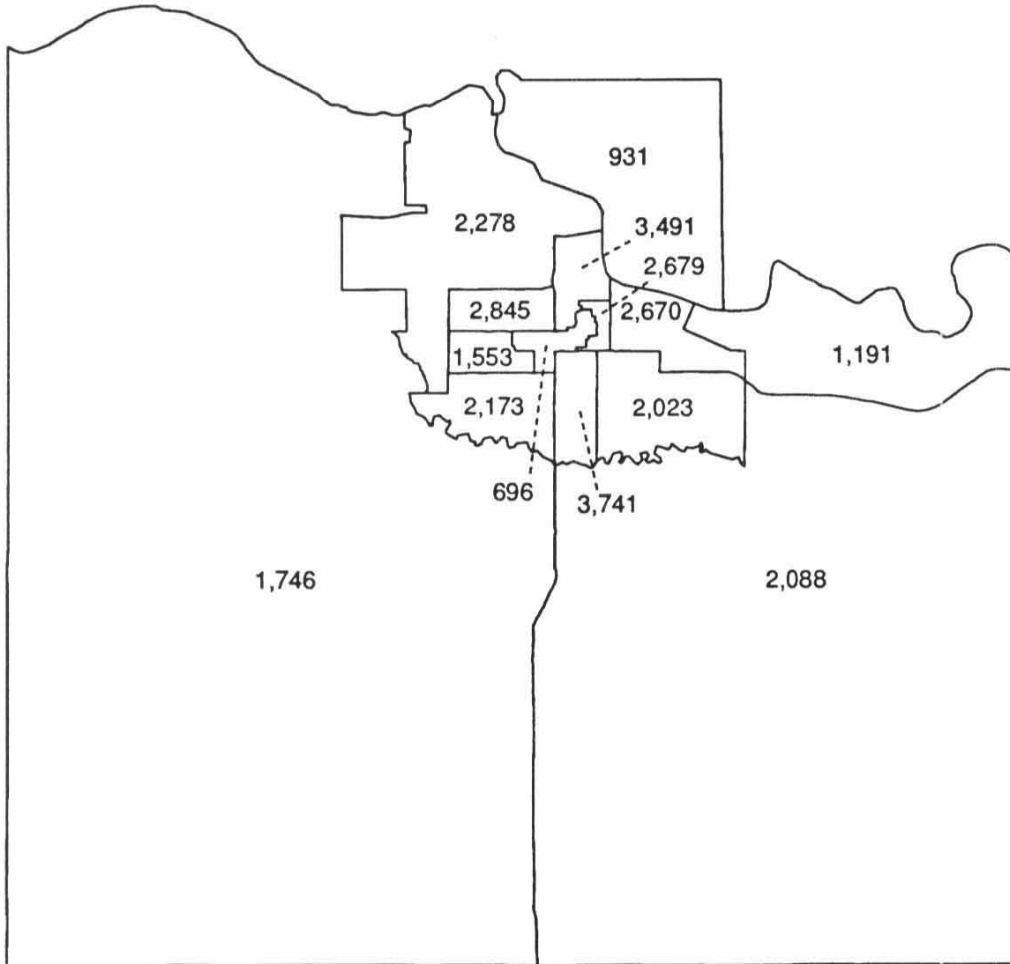
## Median Value of Owner-Occupied Housing Units, 1990

# Number of Households, 1990

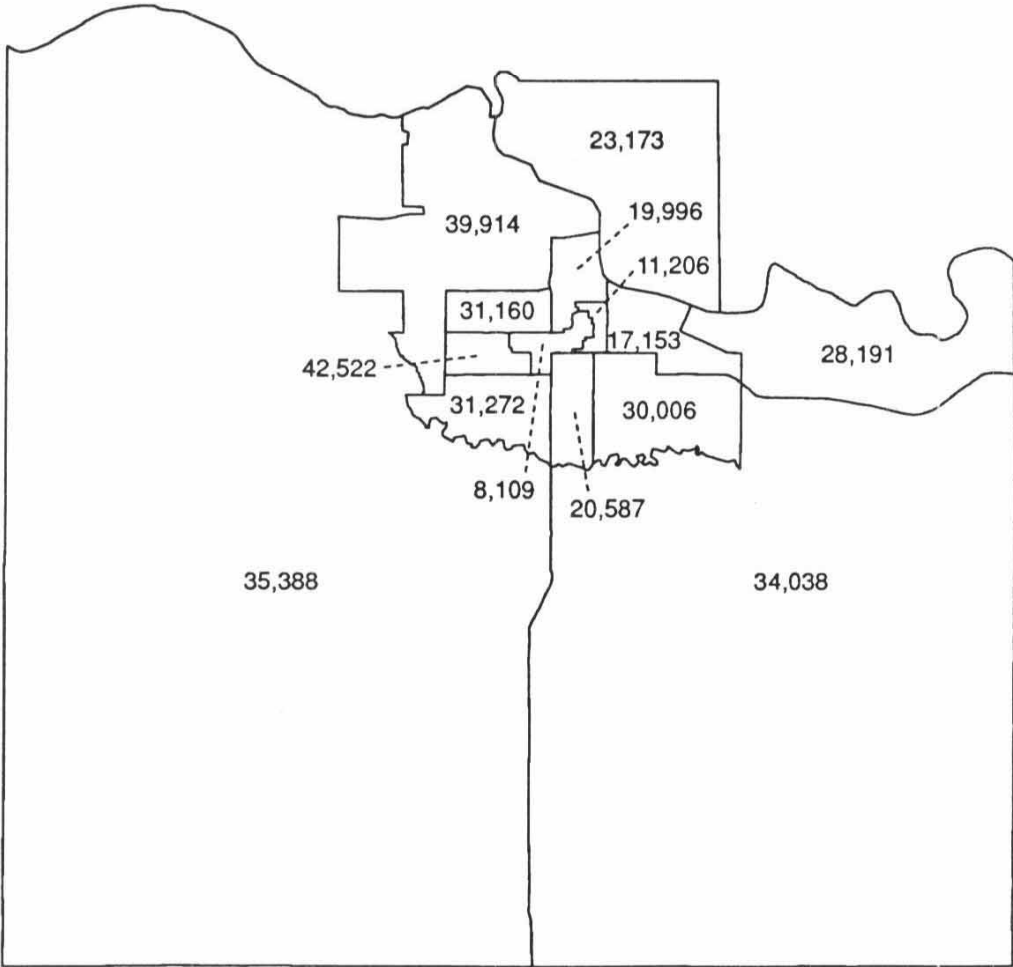

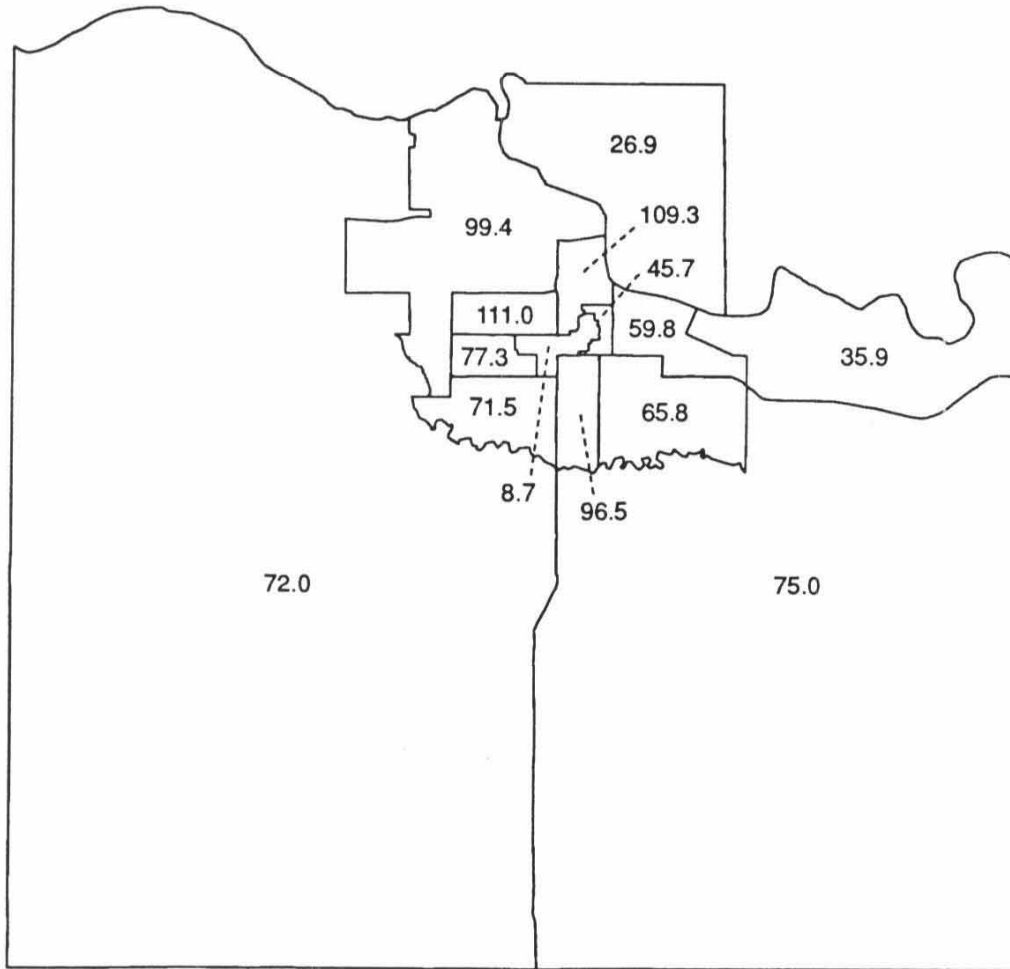
# Median Household Income, 1989

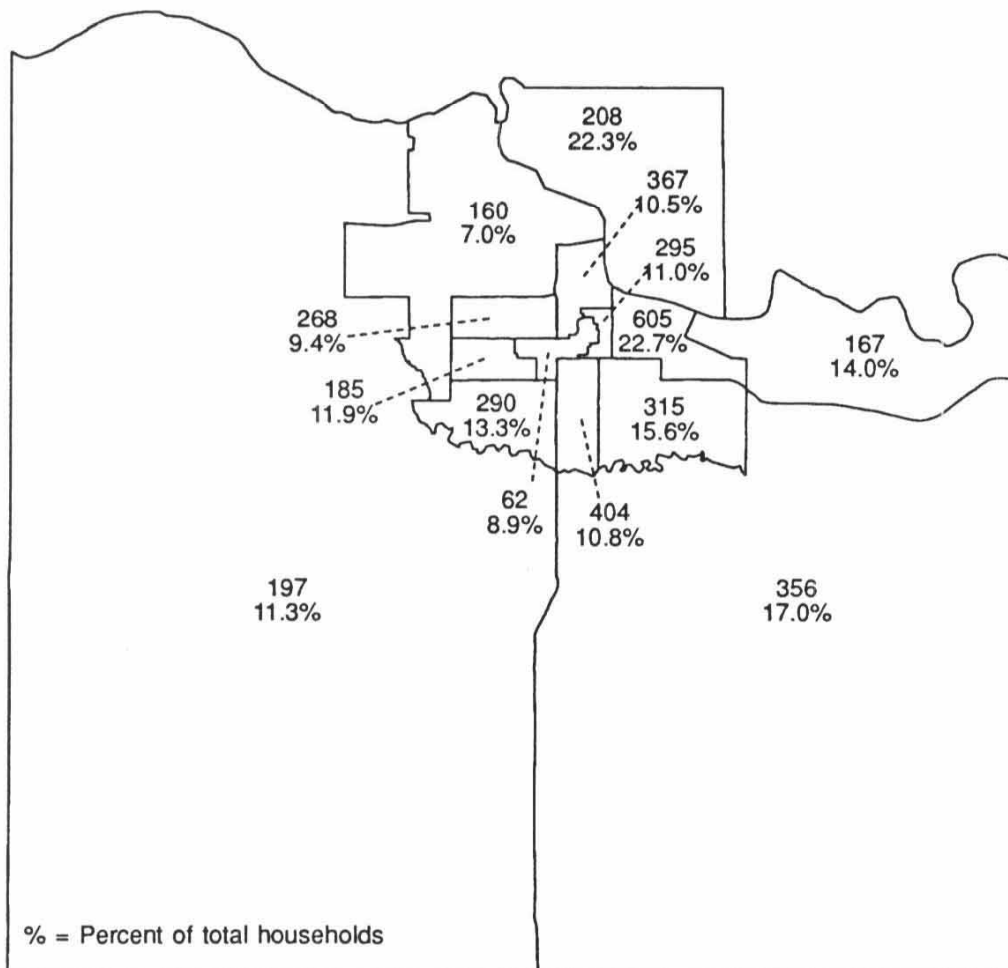
Aggregate Household Income, 1989
